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
### **OZCF/ZSO Navroze Function – 2018**

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## Teenaz Javat - Fabulous at any age!



The City of Mississauga awarded Teenaz Javat the "Absolutely Fabulous Woman Over 40 Achievement Award" on the occasion of International Women's Day 2018.

"By blood Indian, by bond Pakistani and by choice Canadian, would best describe Teenaz Javat, a senior writer at the CBC Toronto. Long before she became a journalist, Teenaz was a story teller. Her stories form part of The Shoe Project, a women-only artists collective that document immigration stories through the lens of shoes.

A multiple award winning journalist, Teenaz was part of a team at CBC Radio's Metro Morning that won the Adrianne Clarkson National Award for a town hall on Domestic violence against women in the GTA. She does not shy away from taking a hard look at topics like Arab Spring and its impact on Canada, or the not-so- uncommon practice of female feticide among some communities in the GTA.

Teenaz came to Canada with an 8-month-old daughter. She has been a stay-at-home mother, a full-time student at Sheridan College, a full-time journalist at the CBC, and an adjunct professor at Sheridan college, all while volunteering in the local school system and editor of her community newsletter.

She lives in Mississauga with her husband Mahveer and children Sherezade and Hormuz. She loves having breakfast with her friends when she is not in the newsroom on the early morning shift."

#### **Zubin Austin – Research Has its Rewards**



Congratulations to Zubin Austin on winning the prestigious President's Impact Award awarded by the University of Toronto!

The President's Impact Awards (PIA) recognize faculty members whose research has led to significant impact beyond academia or a specific field of research, including on society, culture, public policy, law, health, education, quality of life, a profession, the economy, and the environment, through public engagement or the development of products, processes, or services from inventions. Recipients of the Research Impact Award were also considered for the <a href="Carolyn Tuohy Impact on Public Policy Award">Carolyn Tuohy Impact on Public Policy Award</a> that is presented annually under the banner of the U of T Awards of Excellence (AWEX).

PIA Recipients are designated as members of the Impact Academy for a period of five years during which they receive an award of \$10,000 per year to be used toward their research. The Academy will meet to discuss matters relevant to research impact, offer advice to the Vice-President, Research & Innovation, and function as advocates for sustained excellence in research and innovation impact

within and outside of the University. Members of the President's Impact Academy will also be invited to participate in a range of university activities to increase the University's profile on the impact of the research of its community.

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## 100th Toronto-First Zoroastrian Scout Group Report - February 2018

Founder of the Scouting movement, Lord Baden-Powell, popularly known as "B-P", was born on February 22, 1857 – subsequently the Scouts dedicated their meeting on Sunday, February 25 to celebrate his birthday. After the opening ceremony, Beaver-Scout Arshan Gazdar, Cub-Scout Burzina Amroliwalla and Scout Mehzad Antia lit a "divo" each and placed near the B-P's photo. Toronto has been chosen as the 7th Parliament of the World's Religions' host city, to be convened from November 1–7, 2018. More than 10,000 people will participate in the 7-day 2018 Parliament. There will be 500 programs, workshops, and dialogues; alongside music, dance, art and photography exhibitions, and related events presented by the world's religious communities and cultural institutions.

A group of Zoroastrians has already registered to attend the 7<sup>th</sup> POWR. We have put in proposals for artistic performances, a jashan and presentations. We have also booked a booth in the trade show to showcase FEZANA and Zoroastrianism.


## 21 Days to Nawroz

## مناسبتهای گاهشماری ماه آوریل April Chronological occasions

"سیزده به در" – ۲ آوریل

روز دوم آوریل برابر با سیزده فروردین است که به «سیزده به در» یا به تازگی به «روز طبیعت» معروف شده است. هرچند که ده دلایل و چگونگی برگزاری این جشن در طول تاریخ با جزییات روشن نیست اما بهطور عامیانه معروف شده است که به دلیل نحسی عدد سیزده در این روز نباید در خانه ماند و باید این روز را در طبیعت گذراند. اما به تازگی برای مخالفت با نحسی یک عدد یا روز، این روز به «روز طبیعت» نامگذاری شده است که نامی بسیار مناسبتر و زیباتر است و ربطی هم به بد بودن یا خوب بودن روز یا عدد ندارد. مرسوم است که ایرانیان به طور خانوادگی این روز را در طبیعت به بازی، سرگرمی و پیک نیک میگذرانند. سیزدهمین روز زا در طبیعت بگذرانید و به ویژه با طبیعت مهربان باشید.

## "Sizda Bedar" - April 2nd

The second day of April is the thirteenth of Farvardin month, which is known as the "*Sizda Bedar*" or recently called "*Nature Day*". However, the reasons for this celebration are not clear in history, but it's popularly known that it should not stay home at the time of the thirteenth day and should spend this day in nature. But recently, to oppose the blemish of a day or a day, this day has been named "Nature Day", which is a much more appropriate and beautiful name, and has nothing to do with the bad or good of day or number. It is customary for Iranians to celebrate this day in nature, play, entertain and have a picnic. Spend the 13<sup>th</sup> day of Nowruz in nature and be especially kind to nature.

## "حشن فروردینگان" یا "فرودگ" – ۸ آوریل

روز ۸ آوریل برابر با ۱۹ فروردین به روز «جشن فروردینگان» یا «فرودگ» معروف است. این روز اولین جشن ماهیانه در سال جدید است که در آن نام ماه و روز یکی شده است. معمولا جشن فروردینگان را در پیوند با «فروهر درگذشتگان» میدانند. در این روز زرتشتیان ایران مرسوم است که در این روز به آرامگاه میروند و با رفتن بر سر خاک درگذشتگان از آنان یاد میکنند. در زمانهای گذشته که دخمه رایج بوده است، زرتشتیان مراسمهایی را برای درگذشتگان در پایین کوه دخمه یا در محل زندگیشان برگزار میکردند.

## "Farvardingan Jashan" or "Foroudog" - April 8th

April 8, equal with Farvardin 19th, the "Farvardingan Jashan" or known as "Foroudog" is celebrated. This is the first monthly Jashan in the New Year, in which the name of the month and day has been merged. Farvardingan celebrations are usually associated with "Fravahar's of Deaths". On this day Zoroastrians celebrate the memory of their dead(s). Today among Zoroastrians in Iran it is customary to go to the tomb on this day and remember them when they go over the territory of the dead. In the past times, when the catacombs were commonplace, Zoroastrians held ceremonies for the dead at the bottom of the catacombs or in their place of residence.



# Dr. Farhang Mehr: Hopes, Dreams, and Aspirations

The following is an excerpt from "Triumph Over Discrimination: The Life Story of Dr. Farhang

Mehr" by Lylah M. Alphonse. It is republished here with permission from the author.

More than 20 years after he fled from Iran, Mehr is driven by his hopes for the unity of the world's Zoroastrian communities. A Zarathushti by birth and by choice, he has dedicated his golden years to the realization of his hopes, dreams, and aspirations for Zoroastrianism. He describes these dreams in his own words:

This is what I call "The Zoroastrian Odyssey." Zoroastrianism and Zarathushtis are undergoing a tumultuous intellectual and spiritual voyage: An effort by Zarathushtis in Diaspora to preserve their cultural identity. Knowledge about one's religion and culture, one's history and heritage, are some of the tools needed in order to make this Odyssey successful. Other tools required for the journey are freedom of choice, protection of human rights, protection of the environment, global solidarity, and cooperation with the democratic process. Zarathushtis must be dedicated to good thoughts, good words, and good deeds; tolerance and inclusiveness are essential to achieving our goal of maintaining a strong and solid community. We must hold fast to this dream.

I cherish other dreams for the future.

I dream of the preservation of Zarathustra's teachings, which make up the core of Zoroastrianism, and of the preservation of the meaning behind our rituals and customs. The core of our religion is the beliefs and doctrines contained within the Gathas. They are everlasting and unchangeable. They give us the strength to undertake our mental quests. The rituals are described in the literature accompanying the Gathas. The actions of the rituals appeal to our senses. Imbued with meaning, the rituals are a manifestation of the faith, a reminder of our demotion and commitment. Without meaning, rituals become empty motions, devoid of significance. The core and the rituals together are necessary in order to maintain faith. It is possible to be open-minded and acquire new and different political identities without sacrificing one's religious identity. ... When our youths understand the significance of our rituals, they are better prepared to take our religious community into the future, armed with understanding and religious knowledge, confident in themselves and their heritage.

I dream of the formation of a large and flourishing Zoroastrian community. A living religion must also have a vibrant community rich in real religious commitment. Without a community of practicing believers, a religion becomes nothing more than a museum, an artifact, a relic to be viewed by the curious and studied by historians and scientists. We should maintain a community of Zarathushtis in mind and in heart, treading together the path of truth and righteousness. As a single entity we should be showing love, upholding justice, exercising compassion, working for peace, engaging creatively in constructive work. Together we should be practicing good thoughts, good words, and good deeds in order to reach a community-wide goal of enlightenment and unity with Spenta Mainyu and Ahura Mazda. These goals cannot be achieved with the current social and religious attitudes of our fractured community. Though at times difficult, some traditions can -- and should -- be modified as social conditions demand change. In a civil society, issues can be resolved through discussion and the application of reason, goodwill, and compromise. Compromises should not be confounded by hypocrisy, but should come through constructive confrontation and a willingness to work toward the greater good.

I dream of creating unity within the Zoroastrian community. In a quest for survival and in an attempt to fight social ills, the Zoroastrian community has split into three distinct ideological groups: Traditionalists, Reformists, and Moderates. The division in and of itself is not a threat to the solidarity of the Zoroastrian community; it is merely a sign of spiritual awakening and religious revival. In the modern, free world no religion is monolithic. Doctorinal diversity is a product of freethinking -- a value cherished by Zoroastrians and mandated by Ahura Mazda. Religious understanding is no longer the domain of the priesthood; every individual is entitled to knowledge and has the right to study and make inquiries into religion. It is a personal choice. The threat to community solidarity comes, then, not from freethinking, but from intolerance. ... Liberty is the most previous of Ahura Mazda's gifts to humankind. It is a component of divine law. The right to liberty is so undeniable that Ahura Mazda does not curtail humankind's actions, even in regard to one's choice of religion. Intolerance is not a tradition sanctioned by the Gathas. ... The acceptance of people born to non-Zarathushti parents is not a threat to the survival of the religion. The tradition of non-acceptance is a threat to our very existence.

I dream that the spirit of Zarathushtra will live on in our youths. We, the elders of the Zoroastrian community, charge out youths with maintaining the ideals of Zoroastrianism. It is up to you, especially those of you living outside of Iran and India, to prove that Zarathushtis have the talent, motivation, strength, and benevolence needed to flourish in the next millennium. You must lead the way. You must do what is right for righteousness sake. You must be vigilant, working hard to protect and promote Zoroastrian values, and to keep the eternal flame alight.

I am confident that my dreams will come true, and that Zarathushtis will not only survive, but also excel in the years to come.


