MGDM Re-Opening – Reminder of Vaccination Policy

We want to take this opportunity and remind everyone that vaccines are safe, effective and the best way to protect you and those around you from serious illnesses like COVID-19. Freddie Mercury 30th Death Anniversary

BBC Radio 4 has produced a documentary about Freddie Mercury, to mark the 30th anniversary of his death on Saturday 20th November 2021. Presented by award-winning author and journalist Sathnam Sanghera, the documentary explores the lesser-known aspects of Mercury's life – including his Zoroastrian Parsi heritage and his childhood in India and Zanzibar.

Our ZTFE patron Lord Karan F Bilmoria CBE was interviewed for this documentary. BBC Radio 4 talked to Lord Bilmoria about his own background, including the huge success of Cobra beer. Sathnam Sanghera was keen to learn more about the British Parsi community, and how it compares to his experiences as a British Sikh.

Freddie Mercury's family worked for the British Colonial Service, and the BBC was interested to find out from Lord Bilmoria about his family's service for the British Indian Army. As Britain discusses its imperial history, these colonial services reveal the fascinating complexities of that period. The documentary is available for listening using the link below.

مشن دی گان:

همانطور که می دانید در گاهشماری زرتشتی مشن های ماهیانه، مشن های هستند که به مناسبت یکی شدن نام روز و نام ماه مشن گرفته می شوند. بنابراین در هر ماه یک روز به نام مشن آن ماه نامگذاری شده است. برقی از این مشن ها بسیار معروف هستند و درباره پیگونی برگزاری آنها در گذشته نیز آگاهی هایی در اختیار داریم، مانند مهرگان (روز مهر از ماه مهر)، اسفندگان (روز اسفند از ماه اسفند) و ... اما در برقی از موارد کمتر معروف هستند مانند مشن آذرگان (روز آذر از ماه آذر)، اردیبهشتگان (روز اردیبهشت از ماه اردیبهشت). موضوع مشترک بین همه این مشن ها این است که همراه با شادی، گردهم آیی، بزرگداشت و برقی مراسم های مذهبی بوده اند.

اما اگر توجه کرده باشید در گاهشماری زرتشتی چهار مشن دی گان مشخص شده است که عبارتند از «روز اورمزد از ماه دی»، «روز دی بآذر از ماه دی»، «روز دی بمهر از ماه دی» و «روز دی بدین از ماه دی». دلیل این است که «دی» فود یکی از نام های اورمزد و به معنی «دادن، آفریدن» است. به همین دلیل این چهار روز در حقیقت همان نام اورمزد هستند. پس به دلیل برابر شدن نام ماه «دی» و نام روز اول ماه یعنی «اورمزد» و سه نام روز که «دی» را در فود دارند، به عنوان مشن دی گان در نظر گرفته می شوند. هر چند که شوربفتانه به طور سنتی آگاهی دقیقی نداریم که این مشن به طور خاص چگونه در گذشته برگزار می شده است، اما با توجه به مشن های دیگر که همراه با شادی و بزرگداشت و گردهم آیی بوده اند؛ این مشن هم امتالا همینطور بوده است. امیدواریم که آرام آرام با بهبود وضعیت همه گیری، باز هم به دور هم جمع شویم و همه مشن ها را مشن بگیریم.
